#1c) A square foot garden can average 20 pounds of vegetables per season—twice that of conventional planting methods. #2b) A screech owl #2c) It is estimated that 25 species of birds can be seen in the average urban North Texas backyard. #3c) The United States Constitution was signed in 1787. #4c) A compost pile can build up temperatures of 160 degrees Fahrenheit or more. #6c) Pizza sauce may contain Thyme, Oregano, and Rosemary. #7b) The four life stages of a butterfly are: The egg, the larva (caterpillar), the pupa (chrysalis), and the adult butterfly. #7c) A typical Monarch Butterfly may lay between 100 and 300 eggs. #8c) A typical shower takes 25 gallons. A typical dishwasher takes 15 gallons. Washing dishes by hand takes about 5 gallons of water. #9c) The average pomegranate has 613 seeds.
